

PROPOSAL FOR FURNISHING  
BULK MATERIALS  
FOR  
PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The City of D'Iberville will accept sealed proposals from qualified companies for "bulk raw materials, as required.

The materials and services required are described below:

Deliver (f.o.b.) to the Public Works Department or other sites within the City limits, "bulk raw materials"; as follows:

- Red fill dirt, class #9 (60% sand & 40% clay)
- Red "pump sand"
- Crushed limestone Grade #57
- Crushed concrete; Grade #57 (minimum wire, fines, debris, etc.)
- Top soil; class #1
- Sand (fill material) class "C"
- Sand, mason; (washed sand, no fines).

Contractor shall be licensed in the State of Mississippi and will be required to furnish copies of license, Bond, insurance, and USDOT registration (if required), prior to the award of a Contract. Proposal shall consist of the price per cubic yard or ton for materials as listed above. Contract will be awarded to the qualified bidder(s) whose proposal is determined to be most advantageous to the City.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any irregularities or informalities in the proposal process.

The proposals should be sealed and properly marked in the lower left hand corner "**RFP Bulk Materials for Public Works Dept.**" to be opened Friday, August 20, 2010, at 4:00 P.M. at 10383 Automall Parkway, D'Iberville, MS 39540

Hold harmless: contractor agrees that it will, and hereby does, indemnify, defend and hold harmless city of D'Iberville from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, costs and expenses of every kind and nature, including court costs and attorney fees and claims for damages resulting from or arising out of any infringement claim or claim of bodily injury, death or damage to real or tangible personal property caused by contractor and/or its partners, principals, agents, employees or subcontractors in the performance of this contract. City of D'Iberville will notify the contractor in writing of any claim to be indemnified hereunder, of which city has knowledge, and contractor in turn will promptly notify city of any such claim. Contractor shall, at its sole expense, control the defense of such suit to the extent allowed by Mississippi law. The parties agree to cooperate with one another in the defense of any such matter.

Any request for price increase during the term of contract will be rejected. Should this rejection result in the cancellation of the contract, the vendor shall be removed from the qualified bidders list for twenty-four (24) months.

If adverse conditions exists industry wide, modifications to disqualifications may be made as circumstances warrant.

The City reserves the right to request from the vendor an extension of this contract for a second term of twelve (12) months, commencing September 1, 2011, with all prices remaining constant.
