Proposal for Furnishing Cold Milling

City Manager, Mayor and Council Members:

Pursuant to your advertisement, we do hereby submit this proposal for furnishing, as ordered by the city, Cold Milling, to include all labor, equipment, materials, tools and supervision to remove old asphalt/concrete paving throughout the City of D'Iberville. Removal of pavement materials from the city roadways and shoulders by cold-milling shall be to the designated depth, loading, hauling and disposal of the milled materials by the Contractor in accordance with the plans and specifications as directed by the Public Works director or his designated representative. Work will be performed in accordance with the specifications as listed below, for a period of eleven months, beginning November 1, 2007, and reserving the right to request an extension of contract for a second term of twelve months, which is as follows:

Minimum specifications and bid form for all labor, material, and equipment to furnish cold milling of old streets and roads, prior to re-surfacing, for the City of D'Iberville.

Three options:

1. Contractor hauls and retains
2. City hauls and retains
3. Contractor hauls and City retains

General:

1. The Contractor shall ensure that all milled materials are thoroughly swept up and removed from streets and surrounding areas to include curbs, sidewalks and grassy areas. The milled surface shall provide a desirable surface free from gouges, continuous grooves, ridges, oil film and other imperfections of workmanship, and shall have a uniform appearance.
2. The Contractor is responsible for a finished milling product to include close milling around manholes, drain inlet boxes, water valves, etc. All milling work will be performed in accordance with MDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Section 406 – Cold Milling.
3. All bidders must be licensed and bonded in the City of D'Iberville.

4. Successful contractor must provide proof of the following insurance. (To "save harmless" the City of D'Iberville).

Insurance:

General liability	each occurrence	aggregate
Bodily injury	\$300,000.00	\$300,000.00
Property damage	\$100,000.00	\$100,000.00

5. Approved bidder will be responsible for obtaining any necessary permits.
6. The city reserves the right to request a performance bond at the time of contract award.
7. The city reserves the right to request a list of references and current contracts from the vendor.
8. All bidders shall include type of proposed equipment to be used if awarded the bid.
9. Work on each purchase order shall begin within ten (10) working days after issuance, unless an extension is granted by the public works department.
10. The contractor shall be required to maintain traffic control on the portion of the city road system that is involved in the milling operations; including flagman, flashing direction signals, traffic cones and any other personnel or safety devices necessary to provide for the safety of the traveling public and the protection of the incomplete pavement milling until such a time as that portion of the roadway may be released to the normal flow of traffic. All traffic control efforts shall conform to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Procession of the work:

1. The Public Works Department shall determine what street/ road shall receive cold milling. The City of D'Iberville shall issue a purchase order and an estimated project start date.
2. The Public Works Department, in conjunction with the contractor shall determine the sequence of operations and schedule the work. Work may be required outside normal working hours as well as outside peak traffic times.
3. The Public Works Department will inspect all milling for quality and contract requirements.

Method of measurement:

Road/street surfaces removed under this bid will be measured for payment by the total number of square yards removed (ALL THICKNESSES).

Your attention is called to the fact that the state of Mississippi has a reciprocal preference law in regards to resident contractors. The states treatment of non-resident contractor's and the local preference percentage shall be applied in evaluating the bids. It is the responsibility of the vendor to submit a copy of their state's preference law with the bid. Failure to do so may be reason to reject the bid.

Notice to bidders:

All bids are to be submitted on this form and shall be submitted in sealed envelopes marked in the lower left hand corner "**Group C7 - Cold Milling**", to be opened Tuesday, October 30, 2007 at 10:00 A.M. Bids not submitted on this form may be disqualified.

Hold harmless: Contractor agrees that it will, and hereby does, indemnify, defend and hold harmless city of D'Iberville from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, costs and expenses of every kind and nature, including court costs and attorney fees and claims for damages resulting from or arising out of any infringement claim or claim of bodily injury, death or damage to real or tangible personal property caused by contractor and/or its partners, principals, agents, employees or subcontractors in the performance of this contract. The City of D'Iberville will notify the contractor in writing of any claim to be indemnified hereunder, of which city has knowledge, and contractor in turn will promptly notify city of any such claim. Contractor shall, at its sole expense, control the defense of such suit to the extent allowed by Mississippi law. The parties agree to cooperate with one another in the defense of any such matter.

Any request for price increase during the term of contract will be rejected. Should this rejection result in the cancellation of the contract, the vendor shall be removed from the qualified bidders list for twenty-four (24) months. If adverse conditions exists industry wide, modifications to disqualifications may be made as circumstances warrant. The city reserves the right to request from the vendor an extension of this contract for a second term of twelve (12) months, commencing October 1, 2008, with all prices remaining constant.
